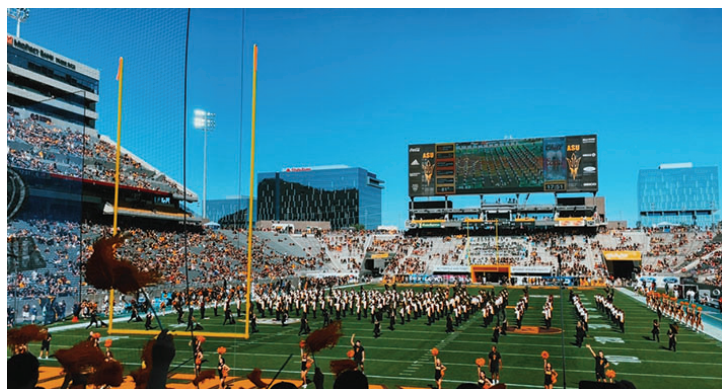


ASU Homecoming Danel Ospanova
